

AN UNDISPUTED SUCCESS

In 2004 the Quickfencer was invented by John Brewer & Steve Rawcliffe when the pair entered the inventor's competition at LAMMA show and won. Without any hesitation, they came home and started a Limited Company, selling 100 machines inside the first year.

The machine saves you both time and money when erecting new fencing, making your job easier and safer. Also, the Quickfencer fencing machine is ideal for the erection of any type of fencing; stock fencing, ranch fencing, cattle fencing, sheep fencing, horse fencing and deer fencing.

At the 2005 show John & Steve came out with a post driver version of the same model and won a prize again.

The Quickfencer 80 unrolls the wire with speeds up to 10mph and you are able to put two 500mt rolls of wire on it. You can put the clamps on and off in less than 1 second, which adds up to double the working capacity. There is also a 120mm (4FT) horse version and a 2mt Deere Fencing version which can also use the 500mt 80cm rolls, plus, there is also now 200mt rolls of horse netting.

In 2008 they came out with the post driver with backshift and fitted the Bryce Suma Mast, which gives movement 2ft side shift, back and side tilt, and using the unique backshift can give as much as 40 inches movement, also there is a 20 inch stabiliser leg.

New for the 2009 LAMMA Show is the 4 strand and 2 strand barbed wire unroller which we won a merit certificate in the best improved section. The 4 strand has fully adjustable spacings and can be used with up to 5 line wires. The 2 strand attachment is fixed and designed to put 2 lines on top of the sheep wire. The machines will also take 2000 mt rolls of barbed wire, working by unrolling the wire semi-tensioned and then to fully tension put a bar and pull to get very high tension using the locking system, which is considerably safer than manual erection.
